

**Agreement between Luxembourg and The Netherlands
regarding protection of analogue television and other transition arrangements during
the transition period as defined in the RRC-06 agreement**

1) The parties agree that the analogue assignments of both parties should be protected during the transition period based on this agreement. The parties further agree to submit a non-conditional declaration for all their analogue assignments versus all digital plan entries of the other party.

2) The parties agree that before implementation of digital entries in the RRC-06 Plan, the implemented assignments should be co-ordinated with the other administration if, according to the complementary analysis, one or more analogue assignments are affected.

As reference for the results of the complementary analysis, the final results, without including the administrative declarations, (digital-to-analogue), as published by the ITU BR before the end of the conference, should be used.

3) The parties agree that all digital entries in the RRC-06 Plan which already have been co-ordinated under the Chester 1997 agreement shall be considered to be co-ordinated with the other administration and that all the necessary agreements in accordance with Article 4 and Article 5 of the RRC-06 Agreement has been obtained.

4) The parties agree that all digital entries which have been co-ordinated under the Chester 1997 and the Wiesbaden 1995 agreement and which are not included in the RRC-06 plan shall be considered as temporarily coordinated until the end of the transition period, unless otherwise mutually agreed on an individual time period, and that all necessary agreements in accordance with Article 4 and 5 in the RRC-06 agreement have been obtained.

5) The parties agree to apply the provisions above in the spirit of facilitating each others transition to the digital plan.
