

AGREEMENT

Concluded between the Administrations of Belgium and Luxembourg

Concerning the date of entry into force of the Agreement between the administrations of Belgium, France, Germany, Luxembourg, The Netherlands and Switzerland on frequency planning and frequency coordination at border areas for terrestrial systems capable of providing electronic communications services in the frequency band 790 - 862 MHz (Brussels 11th October 2011)

Representatives of the Administrations of Belgium and Luxembourg have agreed that The date of entry into force of the Agreement between the administrations of Belgium, France, Germany, Luxembourg, The Netherlands and Switzerland on frequency planning and frequency coordination at border areas for terrestrial systems capable of providing electronic communications services in the frequency band 790 - 862 MHz done in Brussels on the 11th October 2011 for the bilateral frequency coordination between Belgium and Luxembourg is 1st January 2014.
