Coordination agreement between the administrations of The Netherlands and Luxembourg concerning the use of digital terrestrial television broadcasting in the frequency band 470 – 694 MHz

1. Introduction

This agreement is the result of some coordination meetings held in the context of the multilateral coordination group WEDDIP (Western European Digital Implementation Platform) in order to develop a frequency plan for the terrestrial digital TV broadcasting in the frequency range between 470MHz and 694 MHz in light of the allocation of the mobile service in the 700MHz band (694-790MHz).

This agreement is an application of the Agreement “DTT frequency plan in the band 470 – 694 MHz” signed the 29 April 2016 between the administrations of Belgium, France, Germany, Ireland, Luxembourg, The Netherlands and the United Kingdom.

2. Interference field strength limit



Both administrations agree to accept an interference field strength of 50 dB μ V/m at their border, generated by the transmitter networks of the other administration on channels used by both administrations.

3. Revision of the agreement

With the consent of both Administrations, this agreement may be modified if future technical or regulatory developments require such a modification.

4. Date of entry

This agreement enters into force the 28 April 2016.
